

INDEPENDENT STUDY NOTIFICATION for the 2023-24 school year

To comply with the requirements of Assembly Bill 130, the following notification is provided to parents and guardians.

For students in grades K-8, Stellar Charter School offers a long-term Independent Study option which has home-based instruction as well as on-site opportunities, and is supported and monitored by classroom teachers using the same standards-aligned curriculum and substantially equivalent to the quality and intellectual challenge of that provided in the classroom setting.

The choice to enroll in Independent Study and a Charter School is yours; no one can compel a student to participate in Independent Study. This needs to be the right fit for your family and your child/children.

Parents may request a pupil-parent-educator conference meeting prior to enrolling in Independent Study. Parents are also encouraged to tour the campus and meet our team to get a real feel and understand the uniqueness of the program. Parents/guardians who wish to enroll his/her child in long-term Independent Study should contact the school office, (530) 245-7730.

Students enrolled in the long-term Independent Study program will comply with the written agreement which will be put in place at the time of enrollment, and students must comply with the requirements of the program which include:

- Completion of assigned work
- Active participation in synchronous, asynchronous, and live instructional time as assigned
- Make satisfactory academic progress

Parents/guardians who wish for his/her child to return to in-person instruction from Long Term Independent Study shall notify the Independent Study teacher and the School Office and the District will expeditiously facilitate the return, within no more than 5 instructional days. Students who fail to fulfill the requirements of the Independent Study program will be disenrolled from the program and re-enrolled in the regular classroom instruction program.
